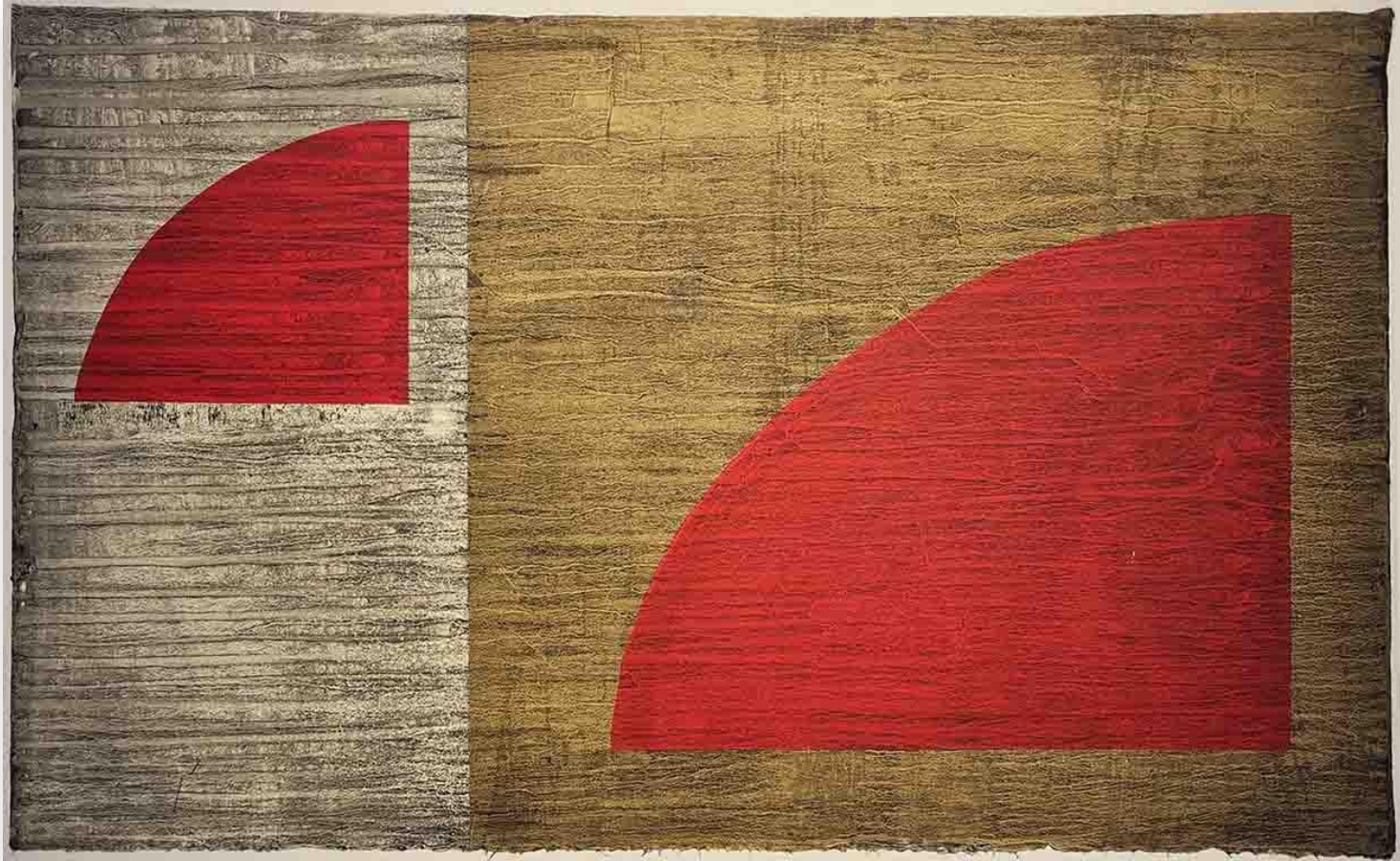
The work presented by Jaume Amigó at Jordi Barnadas gallery has been conceived in front of the Atlantic Ocean, in an immense open space, where man is only an anecdote among majestic sunsets, mists, blizzards and the cyclical movement of the rising and falling of the tide. Jaume Amigó turns his emotion before the elements into art and transcends the individual experience to offer it in forms inspired by the trace of the waves on the sand of the beach, both in the furrows that the water draws and in the vestige of seaweed, shells, wood or pebbles that remain when the tide goes out. This vision, which inspired the painter, is called *nagori* in Japanese culture, and literally means: the trace left by the waves as they recede from the beach. *Nagori* is also the subtle evocation of something ephemeral, of small acts, of aromas and delicate sensations that leave in us the longing of their memory and that make up the memory of our existence. In this way, Amigó incorporates his feelings, inspired by the sunny or misty oceanic landscapes, to his canvases and his works on Japanese paper, works made with pigments of earth tones - characteristic of his last production- and that represent the achievement of his artistic maturity. Jaume Amigó skillfully combines emotional vibrations and chromatic vibrations, making his view of the world also become a testimony of the times we live in.

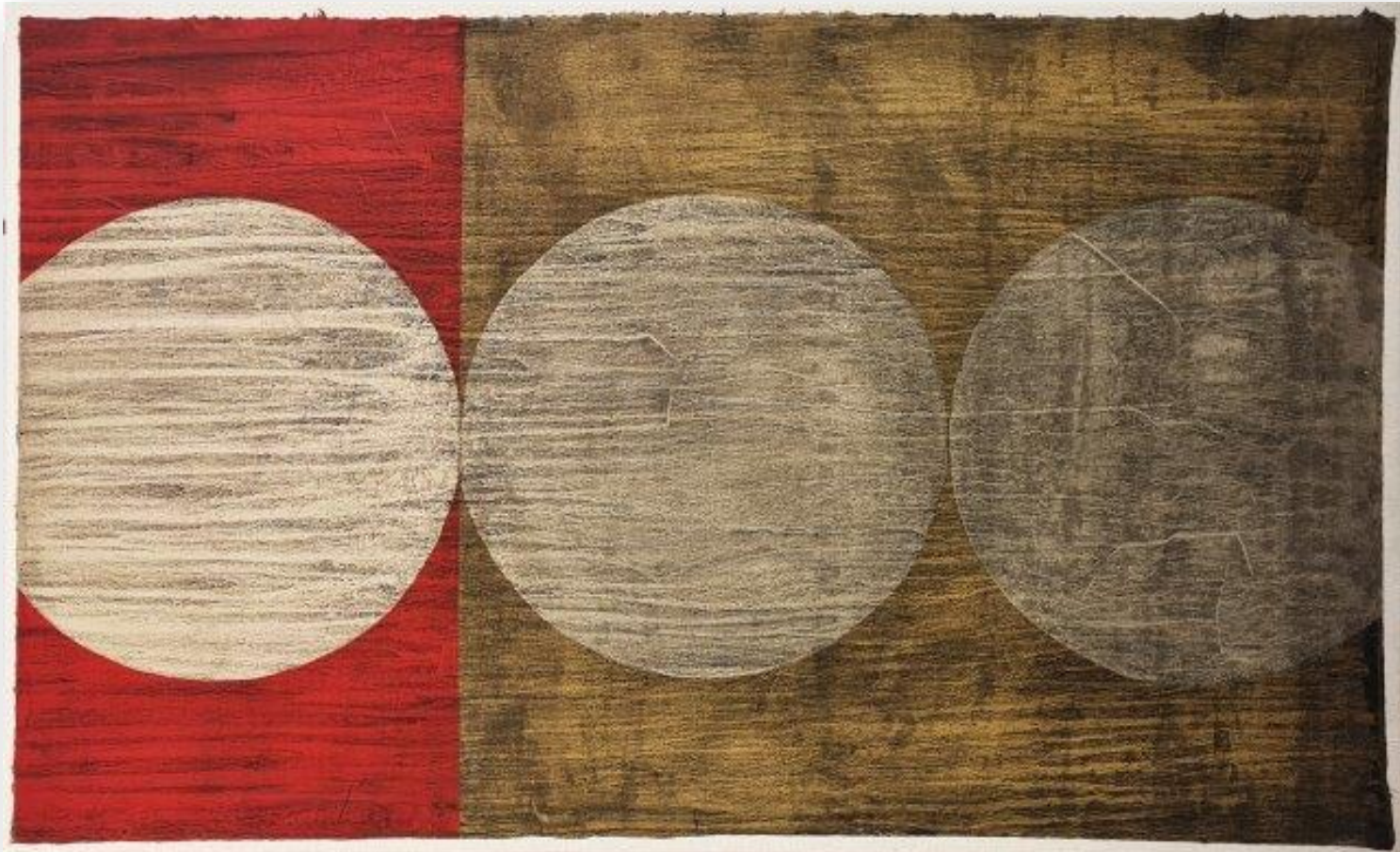

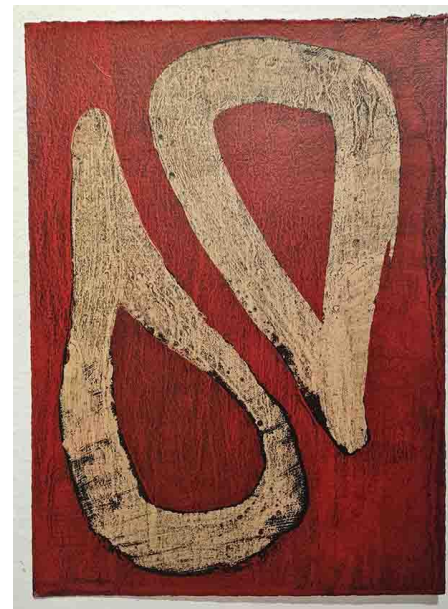

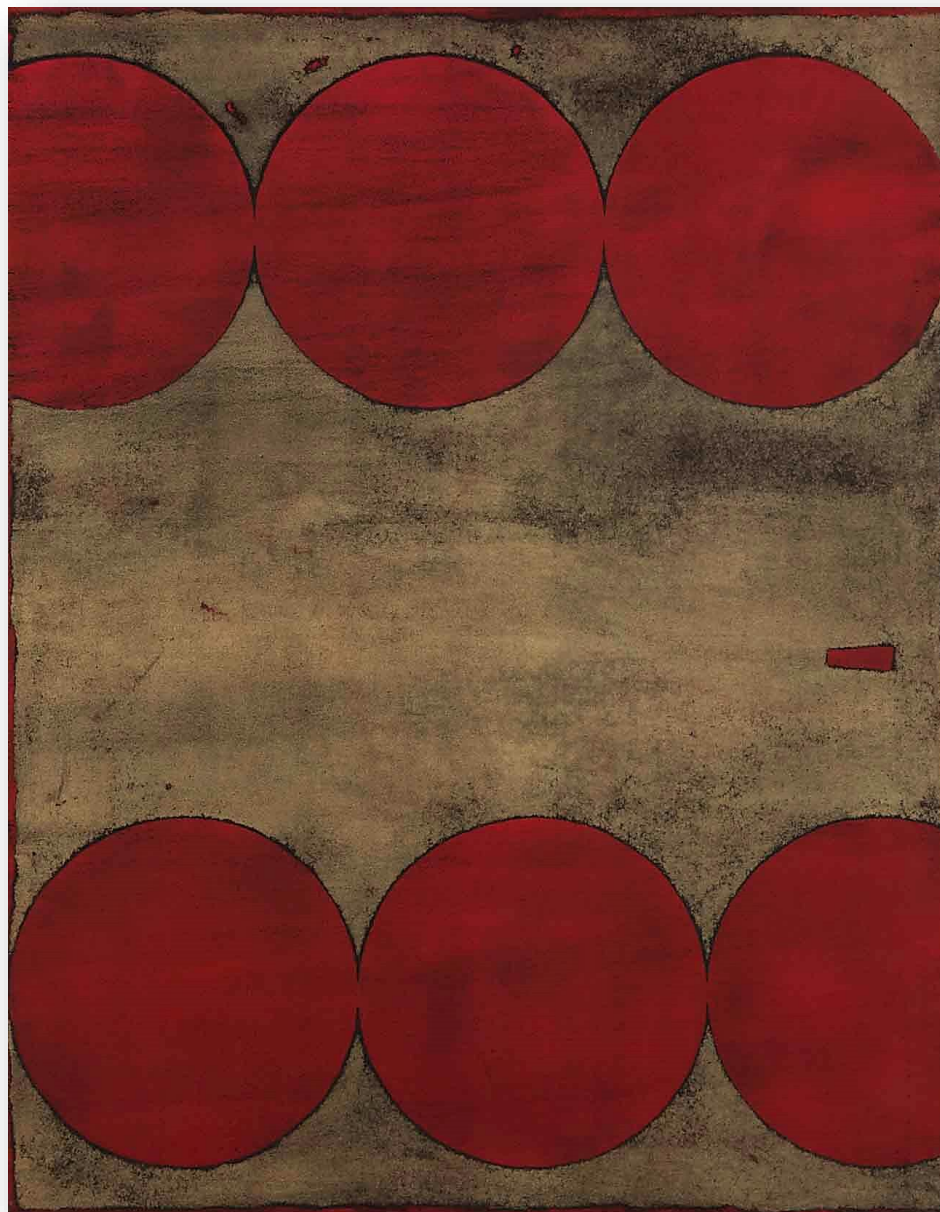
